WI Voter Roll Awareness is Critically Important

[GhostFinder.net](https://ghostfinder.net) is a self-canvassing voter search engine

Mequon, WI (November 29, 2022) – GhostFinder.net now includes 7+ million voters and all 72 counties. It was designed to allow citizens to investigate their address, family members, or anyone else in the state’s voter registration information.

“The purpose is to increase public awareness. You, WI voters, can easily look up your information and see the current state of our voter rolls. GhostFinder.net is gaining traction, and has received 58,267 search requests in the last seven days,” stated designer Kase Kasemodel from StatBandit.

Voters can identify and request the removal of any names in the Wisconsin Elections Commission (WEC) official voting database that are incorrectly associated with their home address. “GhostFinder.net cannot fix the horribly flawed WEC voter database by itself, we need WI Voters to search, learn, and ask questions” said Kasemodel.

He goes on to explain that after voters reviewed their data, many asked:

- How can one person have many voter registration numbers (VRN)? E.g., Mary Ellis
- Why does Dane County have sequential VRNs for unrelated names and addresses?
- Why does WEC keep undeliverable addresses in the voter roll?

“Our elections are so important as they affect every aspect of our lives, we have to take it upon ourselves to ensure that they are run correctly and are not easily manipulated for fraud. I encourage all WI voters to review their information and to share this site with others,” said Dave Loda from Winnebago GOP who is very active in the election integrity movement.

Wisconsin has a total population of 5.9 million and roughly 3.6 million voted in 2020 general election. With the WEC voter rolls around 7.2 million, that leaves 50% (3.6 million) of the WEC voter roll available for ghost voters due to the WEC’s handling of voter statuses.

There is no charge for searching or using this online tool. The system can be easily updated when new voter roll data becomes available.

StatBandit, who created GhostFinder.net, is a small group of designers, mathematicians and programmers, who have worked together for decades, became involved with election integrity data analysis in June of 2021.
