### GhostFinder.net Launches Version 3c - Now Includes All 72 Counties

GhostFinder.net is an open-source self-canvassing on-line voter search engine and voter challenge tool that citizens use, at no charge, to locate and request correction of any names in the official voting database who are incorrectly associated with their home address or an address of a friend or family member.

A voter roll search prototype was initially developed and hosted on Statbandit.com. The prototype was moved to AP76.org in 2021 and coined GhostFinder. The GhostFinder prototype on AP76.org had about 2 million of the 7 million voters in the WEC voter rolls.

GhostFinder version 3 was created in February of 2022 when we purchased GhostFinder.net. The current version V3c now includes 7+ million voters from all 72 counties. Why is the number 7+ million important? Wisconsin has a total population of 5.9 million and roughly 3.6 million voted in 2020 general election. With the WEC voter rolls around 7.2 million, that leaves 50% (3.6 million) of the WEC voter rolls available for ghost voters due to the WEC's handling of voter statuses. GhostFinder.net is gaining traction, having received 56,967 search requests in the last seven days.

GhostFinder.net can be easily updated as new voter roll data becomes available. The search feature has been expanded to run reports by searching in seven different fields. This makes GhostFinder.net a fast and useful tool on laptops and on mobile devices.

Average response time to find someone in Wisconsin is now about 6 seconds, 4x faster than Version 1. Scheduled next for [GhostFinder.net](https://ghostfinder.net), is the addition of a feature that allows users to investigate and document on their own anomalies and inconsistencies in the Wisconsin voter database.

#### About StatBandit

StatBandit is a small group of designers, mathematicians and programmers, who have worked together for decades and became involved with election integrity data analysis in early 2021. **VBAN** (<https://StatBandit.com/VBAN>) is an example of one of the many early StatBandit tools developed to allow anyone to look-up vote/ballot results for their county, city, town, village or polling location.
